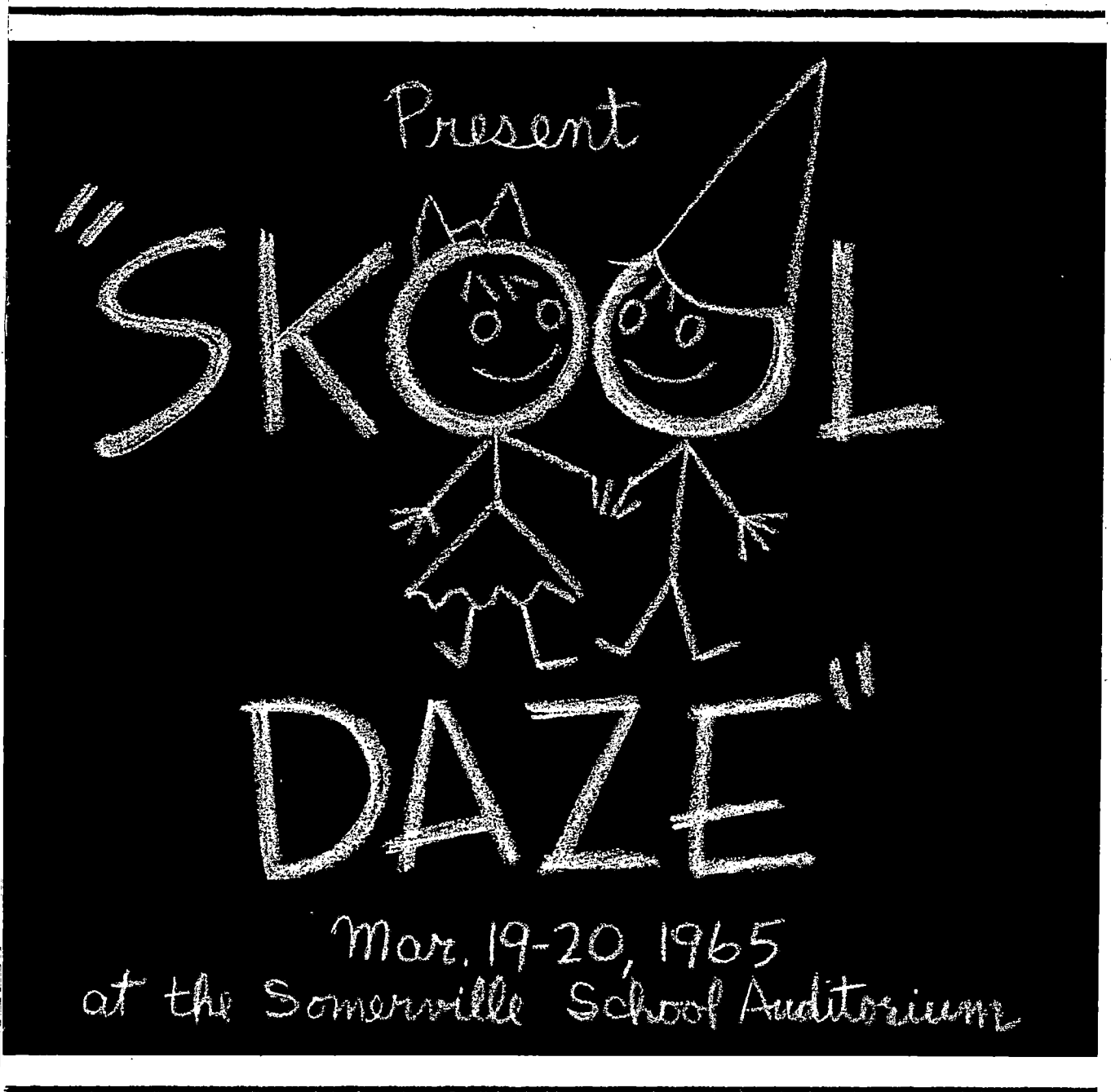

Twenty-one years ago in Old Kenilworth School, a group of Dads organized a show to raise money for school projects and to contribute to the regular P.T.A activities.

This first show provided a lot of fun for the Dads and was well received by children and adults alike. Two years later attendance and school enrollment had outgrown Kenilworth School and the High School auditorium was used until the present Somerville School was ready. Our show has also grown from a one-night stand to four performances playing to an audience of over 2,000.

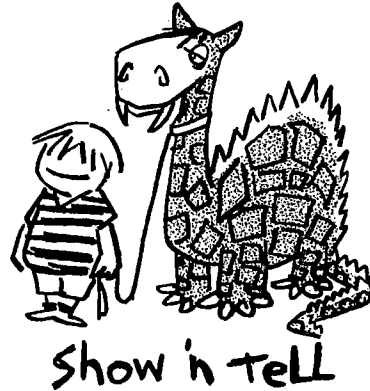

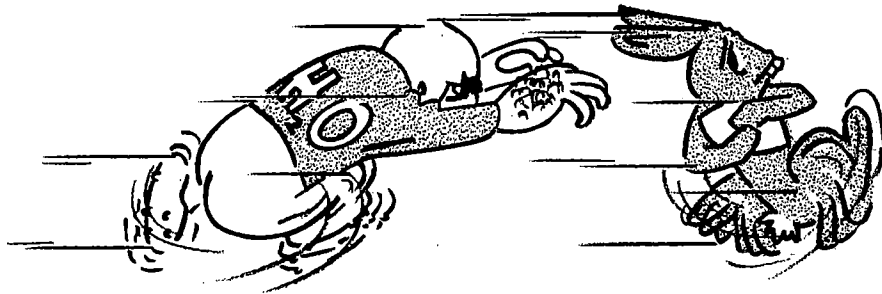
