ABOUT DAD'S NITE

Thirty-nine years ago in old Kenilworth School, a group of Dads organized a show to raise money for school projects and to contribute to the regular Home and School activities.

This first show provided a lot a fun for the Dads and was well received by the children and adults alike. Two years later attendance and school enrollment had outgrown Kenilworth School and the High School auditorium was used until the present Somerville School was opened in 1951. Our show has also grown from a one-night stand to three performances playing to an audience of over 1,500. With the opening of Hawes School in February, 1966, their Dads have continued to work and to participate in the show, for the benefit of both schools. The show is now known as the "Dads' Nite Show" of Somerville-Hawes Schools.

Conversion of unused basement room to all-purpose room, complete with stage, curtain and asphalt tile floor; all work done by volunteer Dads. Room used for physical education activities, meetings, and dramatics, thus relieving scheduling pressure on regular auditorium gymnasium.

Conversion of former bicycle room, located under auditorium-gymnasium, to music room. Dads provided materials and labor for an especially designed suspended ceiling to prevent noise from gym activities from interfering with music program. This noise shield weighs over two tons. Each class meets with music teacher in this room weekly.
